

The "One Another's" of Scripture

New International Version

1. (Romans 12:10 NIV) Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves.
2. (Romans 12:16 NIV) Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.
3. (Romans 14:13 NIV) Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in your brother's way.
4. (Romans 15:7 NIV) Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.
5. (Romans 15:14 NIV) I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to instruct one another.
6. (1 Corinthians 1:10 NIV) I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought.
7. (Galatians 5:13 NIV) You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature ; rather, serve one another in love.
8. (Ephesians 4:2 NIV) Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.
9. (Ephesians 4:32 NIV) Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
10. (Ephesians 5:19 NIV) Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord,
11. (Ephesians 5:21 NIV) Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.
12. (Colossians 3:13 NIV) Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
13. (Colossians 3:16 NIV) Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.
14. (1 Thessalonians 5:11 NIV) Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.
15. (Hebrews 10:24 NIV) And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.
16. (James 4:11 NIV) Brothers, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against his brother or judges him speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it.

17. (1 Peter 1:22 NIV) Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for your brothers, love one another deeply, from the heart.
18. (1 Peter 4:9 NIV) Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.
19. (1 Peter 5:5 NIV) Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
20. (1 John 1:7 NIV) But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

How do we help the church manifest these one anothers? (General help)

- Teach Them – the first thought that came to my mind is that we need to remind them how they must treat one another. Some know, some need to be reminded and some may not have a clue...and some refuse to adjust their life to apply these scriptures.
- Promote Them – I think many of these one anothers happen within the framework of smaller ministries in the church. We need to promote this atmosphere in our meetings, ministries and small group gatherings
- Uphold Them – There needs to be accountability in the way we respond to one another. I think we need to let people know when they are successful and where they are failing.
